In the case of genealogy publications, a "family name" does not belong to one person alone. Most of the data in this kind of publication originally came from "PUBLIC RECORDS". In many cases the public record is no longer available, due to mishap, fire, or carelessness of some public employee. It is vital that family genealogy researchers be able to use old "Orphaned" publications to further their research into there family name.

Please do not restrict the use of "Orphan" genealogy publications.
